The Benton County Historical Society was established in 1951 to preserve and share the history of Benton County. In 1980 we opened the Philomath Museum in the Philomath College Building which had been saved and restored for our use. Built in 1867, the Philomath College Building is on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Philomath Museum has two exhibition galleries where we feature artifacts from our extensive collection and local/regional art. We also have a research library (open by appointment) and a small museum store.

In 1995 Oregon State University announced the closure of their Horner Museum. BCHS stepped forward to save the collection, which had been built by professors at the university for the benefit of our community. After ten years of negotiations we acquired the collection and moved it into our newly-built Johnson Collections Center behind the Philomath Museum.

After our storage needs were sorted out, we turned our attention to our display needs. Acquiring the Horner Museum collection doubled the number of artifacts in our care. We needed more space to share them with the public.

Designed by Allied Works Architecture (Portland and New York City) and LEED certified, the Corvallis Museum was scheduled to open in April 2020. We finally opened our doors in February 2021, in the midst of COVID restrictions. In July 2021 the restrictions were lifted, and we began to operate in earnest.

The Corvallis Museum has four major exhibition spaces, with small displays tucked in between. One exhibition space is for temporary exhibitions of art or history. Three others are permanent exhibit spaces, exploring the history of Benton County and of Oregon State University. We also have two rental spaces and a museum store offering locally made items and a great selection of books.

The Philomath Museum is open 10-4:30 Wednesday through Saturday.

The Corvallis Museum is open 10-4:30 Wednesday through Saturday and 12-4:30 on Sundays.



A Piece of Corvallis Tradition....

Burst's Chocolates has been a favorite local tradition since it opened in 1938. During tough and lean times in Corvallis, Rhea Burst, a long-time resident of Corvallis, said to her husband, Charlie, "What we could use in this town is a handmade chocolate shop." So just three months later, the Burst's decided to try what many only dream of: to make a living making chocolate! They opened their doors on the first floor of a brand new building at 353 SW Madison Avenue in Corvallis, Oregon, where the business still resides today.

Charlie worked in a small kitchen in the back of the store, creating handmade candies and tempering his chocolate on a marble slab. Rhea worked the front of the store, selling chocolates and candies to families looking for high quality, special treats they could afford in these difficult times. From the beginning, Charlie and Rhea believed "any kid with a penny in their pocket should be able to come in and get a piece of candy." The Burst's tradition of quality and value had begun. Not having children to pass the business on to, Charlie and Rhea sold their dream and legacy to Ralph Batmen in 1957. From his first day in the shop, Ralph continued the Burst's tradition of producing the highest quality chocolates and, as he did, the business thrived. Through the 1960s, the Burst's reputation for excellence grew throughout the Willamette Valley. Then, fifteen years after taking over from the Bursts, Ralph Batmen decided to retire as well, and sold the business to Don and Rosemary Burck in 1972.

Then came the early 1980s and recession. The Oregon economy took a turn for the worse. Through hard work and devotion to the legacy of Burst's Candies, Don made sure that Burst's weathered the downturn.

Harkening back to Charlie and Rhea's original commitment, Don kept his quality high and his prices affordable so second and third-generation customers could continue to enjoy a special "treat" in these very difficult times. Enter yours truly, Patrick Magee. As Burst's success ebbed and flowed in the 1970s and 80s, I was growing up just down the road from Corvallis. I was the first child in a family with a legacy of chefs and a love of good food. So it was no wonder I grew early on to love the fine chocolates and candies of Burst's.

After graduating from Oregon State University, I lived abroad for three years and learned the art of cooking. In 1996 I moved back home with the intent of returning to Europe after a year to continue my career. While in Corvallis and needing work, I remembered how much I enjoyed my experiences and the chocolates at Burst's as I was growing up. After introducing myself to Don Burck, I was hired on the spot for a dream job, working as a confectioner in the kitchen of Burst's Candies! As the end of my "year" in Corvallis grew closer, my desire for a life in Europe seemed farther and farther away.

Sensing this change, and knowing I would be up to the challenge of carrying on the traditions that Ralph Batmen and Charlie and Rhea Burst had worked so hard to build and sustain, Don Burck offered to sell me the business, to let me own and become part of the legacy of Burst's Candies.

It has been a wonderful, challenging, and rewarding 20 years! It is my pleasure to share with you not only this 80-year history of chocolate making at Burst's, but also my commitment to manufacturing premium, luxury chocolates. For over four generations, Burst's Chocolates has sweetened countless lives in Oregon's lush Willamette Valley. 

The Gazette-Times is the major source of daily news for our community, and has roots that stretch back in Corvallis and Benton County for more than a century. The first daily edition of the Gazette-Times dates back to June 15, 1909, and came in the wake of a merger between two existing Corvallis papers, the Gazette and the Times. A coin flip determined which part of the name -- "Gazette" or "Times" -- would come first on the masthead.

In 1915, a portion of the paper's ownership was bought by Claude E. Ingalls; another share of the paper's ownership was bought in 1923 by Myron K. Myers. Myers' son, Bruce, later shared ownership with Ingalls' son, Robert, and the two sons assumed the top positions at the paper when their fathers retired in 1950.

Lee Enterprises bought the G-T for \$2 million on Oct. 1, 1969; the same month, work began on a new plant for the G-T, and the paper moved three blocks into that new building in August 1971. In October 1983, the paper expanded to seven days a week, adding a Sunday edition, and converted from an afternoon newspaper to a morning paper.

Robert Ingalls remained publisher of the paper until 1982, when the company appointed Thomas S. Jenks to the top job. He was succeeded in 1989 by Thomas J. Watson, who was replaced by Beth Clark in 1991. Gary Sawyer succeeded her in 1996 and Brenda Speth was appointed publisher in 2001, to be followed by Mike McInally in 2005.

Every morning, 13,000 copies of the Gazette-Times are delivered to doorsteps, retail outlets and vending machines throughout Corvallis and Benton County. By days' end, more than 35,000 people in the marketplace have read the Gazette-Times -- and thousands more have logged onto the paper's Web site, www.gazettetimes.com.

Our readers look to us to provide a variety of information about local community issues, plus sports, weather, entertainment and advertisements for local goods and services. For local business owners the newspaper provides an efficient way to reach potential customers via display, classified, inserts and online advertising. Even though readers count on us for information about the nation and world, the Gazette-Times' primary focus is to offer news and information about Corvallis and Benton County -- information that isn't available from any other source.







STATE TREE

Douglas Fir (Pseudotsuga menziesii) designated Oregon's state tree in 1939, is the principal timber species in the United States. A tree of large size and magnificent form, its wood is the most important in the world, due to its strength and stiffness combined with its moderate weight. Greatest value is for structural timber, although it has a thousand uses.

Oregon has more Douglas fir and produces more of its lumber than any other state.

STATE FISH

The Chinook Salmon (Onocorhynchus tschawytscha) "a distinctive economic and recreational asset," was declared State Fish by the 1961 Legislature.





STATE BIRD

The Western Meadowlark (Sturnella neglecta) was chosen in 1927 by Oregon's school children in a vote sponsored by the Oregon Audubon Society. Perhaps the most popular and familiar of western birds, it has bright colors, fearless behavior and a loud and cheerful song.

STATE ROCK

The 1965 Legislature declared the Thunderegg the official state rock after rockhounds throughout Oregon voted the Thunderegg their unanimous choice. While drab and uninteresting on the outside, when cut and polished, they reveal beautiful designs in a wide variety of colors. They are found chiefly in Malheur, Wasco, Jefferson, Wheeler and Crook Counties.





STATE ANIMAL

The American Beaver (Castor canadensis) was named Oregon State Animal by the 1969 Legislature. Prized for its fur, the beaver was heavily trapped during the 19th century. Through proper management and partial protection, the beaver has come back and is now common in the waterways throughout the state. Oregon is sometimes referred to as the "Beaver State", and Oregon State University's athletic team is called the "Beavers".

STATE FLOWER

The Oregon Grape (Berberis aquifolium) grows primarily in the western area of the state. Resembling holly, with its small yellow flowers and bright berries against a deep green waxy leaf, the plant remains green year 'round.
